Magazines	Paper cups (take to Morrisons car park)
Shredded paper (small quantities)	Glass (use green glass box)
Cereal boxes (but not the plastic lining)	Polystyrene
Greetings Cards (new ones to WWV Cranborne)	Foil/Foil trays (Take to Morrisons car park)
Cardboard (including corrugated card)	General rubbish and Commercial Waste
Plastic Bottles (including milk, soft drinks, shampoo and shower gel, cleaning products)	Crisp Packets (Take to Potter's Wheel car Park Verwood)
Plastic pots (including yoghurt, cream, soup)	Clothes and Textiles (Take to Morrisons/Fire Station car parks)
Plastic tubs (including margarine, butter, ice cream)	Plant pots and seed trays (return to garden centre)
Plastic trays (any colour, including fruit and vegetable punnets)	Food Waste (use brown food waste bin or compost)

Hedge Cuttings	Any non-organic waste
Grass Cuttings	Branches with a diameter of more than 15cm
Twigs and small branches	Logs and tree stumps
Plants	Invasive weeds (Japanese Knotweed, Ragwort)
Cut Flowers	Soil, bricks, rubble, stones, rocks
Leaves	Plastics, such as compost bags, plant pots and seed trays)
Small amounts of home-grown fruit and vegetables	Ashes
	Animal faeces and bedding

Leftovers, including plate scrapings	Liquids
Tea bags and coffee grounds	Oil or liquid fats
Pasta, rice and egg shells	Paper cups of any kind

Use compostable caddy liners or newspaper.
